Which beach would you recommend in Paphos?

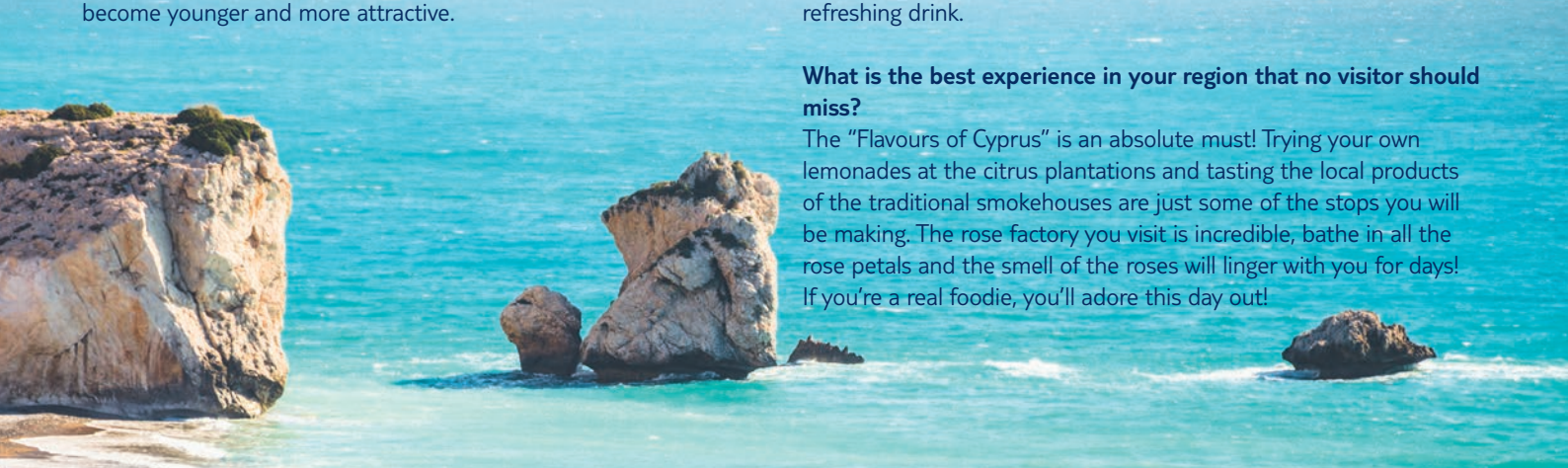

Whilst in Paphos you must try a Brandy Sour – such a refreshing drink.

What is the best experience in your region that no visitor should miss?

The "Flavours of Cyprus" is an absolute must! Trying your own lemonades at the citrus plantations and tasting the local products of the traditional smokehouses are just some of the stops you will be making.
