### Which places would you recommend in Fuerteventura?

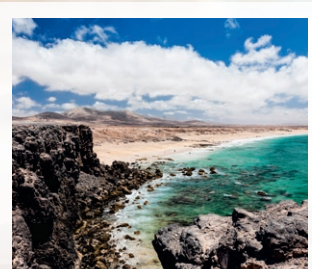

### What local food should visitors try in Fuerteventura?

The "Papas arrugadas" with mojo sauce have been voted one of the best tapas amongst all Spanish tapas! An unusual local product is definitely what we call "Gofio". It is toasted corn or wheat flour which is mixed into many things such as coffee, soups or desserts.

### What is the best experience in your region that no visitor should miss?

The centre of the island is gorgeous. The beautiful rounded mountain tops emit a sense of tranquillity. My favourite excursion is "Fuerteventura uncovered" where you visit an old lighthouse in the North and stop on the tallest mountain in the centre of the island to enjoy the stunning views. You will also see the small, historic village of Betancuria and a local goat farm. But the highlight is definitely the lunch in one of the best restaurants on the island!
